#### Systematic Planning

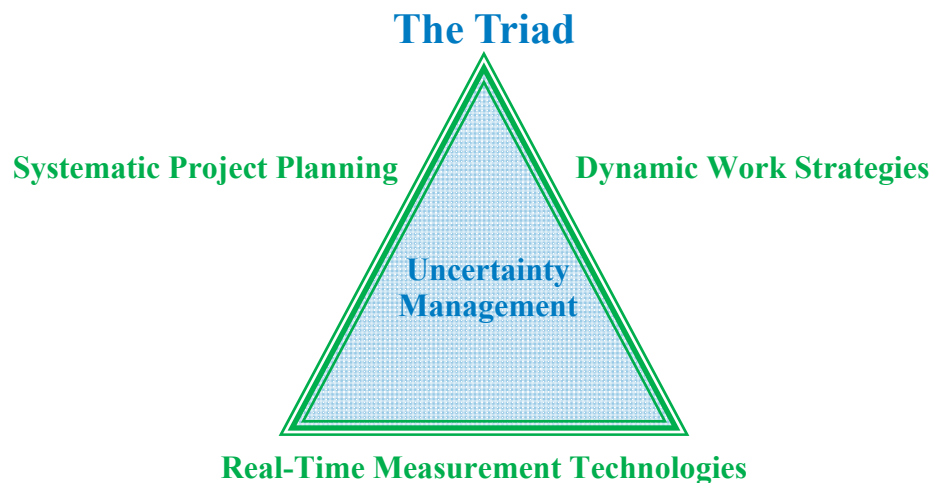
- ◆ Ensures that end goals are clearly identified.
